Timer shall be electromechanical cam-style with 25 AMP rated switch to operate dryer for 30 second period. Hand dryers shall be listed under reexamination service of Underwriters Laboratories, Inc.



Placement Instruction

- Hand dryers should be spaced at least 2' apart, near but not over the wash basin
- In congested areas, dryers should be located to create a flow from wash basin to dryer to exit
- Dryer Quantity Recommendation:

Average Traffic: 1 dryer per 2 wash basins Heavy Traffic: 1 dryer per wash basin

Industrial 54" Circular wash fountains: 4 dryers per sink

· Recommended mounting heights from floor to dryer bottom edge
